CONDITIONS / QUALIFICATIONS AND FURTHER INFORMATION:

1. Qualifications

Open to female golfers who are members of a County Association within the Midlands North Region, who have Amateur Status in accordance with the current R&A Rules Limited and who hold a COMPETITION CONGU Handicap.

2. Regulations

a) Entry Forms accompanied by the appropriate Entry Fee, must reach the Organiser by the closing date.

b) There shall be a limit of 40 couples. If the competition is oversubscribed, there will be a waiting list. Substitutions will be allowed after the closing date at the discretion of the Organiser.

c) Competitors should register at the Registration Desk no later than 20 minutes before their first tee-off time.

d) A COMPETITION CONGU Handicap Certificate or CDH number must be produced at Registration.

e) In the event of inclement weather the Organiser reserves the right to decide over how many holes the competition is played and how the prizes are awarded

f) Money will not be refunded after the draw has been made unless places can be filled from a waiting list.

g) Players aged under 18 years must produce a copy of their current Parental Consent Form

3. Format & Conditions

a) The competition shall consist of 36 holes stroke play foursomes from the Red Medal Tees.

b) The combined handicap shall not exceed 36.

c) The competition will be played in accordance with the Rules of Golf as approved by the R&A of St Andrews, Local Rules of the Club and Standard Conditions of Competition (Hard Card)

d) A player may obtain distance information by using a device that measures distance only. If, during a stipulated round a player uses a distance-measuring device that is designed to gauge or measure other conditions that might affect her play (e.g. gradient, wind speed, temperature etc.) the player is in breach of Rule 14.3 for which the penalty is disqualification, regardless of whether any such additional function is actually used.

e) Players shall walk at all times unless permitted to ride by the organising committee on production of a current medical certificate. (Refer to Golf England Transportation Policy)

f) Competitors must not engage a professional or assistant professional as a caddy. Penalty for breach of rules is disqualification.

4. Trophies & Prizes

a) Winners of the 36 hole net score shall hold the Challenge Cup for 1 year

b) Winners of the 36 hole gross score shall hold the Scratch Salver for 1 year

c) In the event of one couple recording both best nett and gross scores they shall hold both trophies for 1 year and receive the 1st Nett Prize.

d) Prizes will be awarded for other aggregate rounds in the morning and afternoon. No couple shall receive more than one prize.

e) All ties shall be decided on the last 18, 9, 6, 3, or 1 hole.
