

## NCLGA COUNCIL MEETING

Notes of the meeting held at 10.30 am Monday 11<sup>th</sup> July 2022  
at Beeston Fields Golf Club

**Present:** NCLGA Council members and ladies secretaries/club representatives from Nottinghamshire affiliated clubs, 42 attendees including NCLGA exec plus 4 EG representatives.

### 1. Apologies for absence

Clare Jones, Midland North Representative, outlined the format of the day to the attendees seated as designated tables

The meeting had the format of an interactive workshop with England Golf representatives leading the discussions:

The four topics covered were

- (i) Social Media and Communications: the digital platform age
- (ii) Development: how to recruit and retain more women
- (iii) Volunteering and Governance: the practicalities of running a women's section
- (iv) Women in Golf Charter: how clubs can become involved

The 20 minute discussions on social media/communications, volunteering and governance and women's development allowed club representatives to share issues, good practice and approaches to these areas.
